

By-Law No 1 – FFA Competition Rules

The competition rules for the conduct of all competitions sanctioned by the Board of Fly Fish Australia shall be published as a stand-alone set of rules and referred to as **FFA Competition Rules (FFACR)**. Only those competitions authorised by the Board and conducted in accord with the published rules as amended from time to time may earn ranking points for anglers toward team selection. The FFA Competition Rules shall be in alignment with the FIPS Mouche International Rules and modified as required to suit Australian conditions.

By-Law No 2 – Membership Categories and Fees

Having regard to Clause 19 of the Constitution the following shall apply:

The membership application fee as prescribed in Clause 19(a)(i) shall be \$Nil.

The annual membership fees payable with respect to Clause 19(a)(ii) are:

- Adult Member - \$100 per annum
- Youth Member - \$50 per annum
- Life Member – paid life membership not currently available

In accord with Clause 19(b) of the Constitution, the annual membership term shall be from 1 July to 30 June inclusive.

By-Law No.3 – Membership Alignment with Chapter

Members, or those joining Fly Fish Australia Inc. as members, can nominate the Chapter they wish to be aligned with for the purpose of participating in the sport of competition fly fishing, provided the chapter they nominate covers a geographic area that the relevant member lives in, or resides in for at least two calendar months per year
